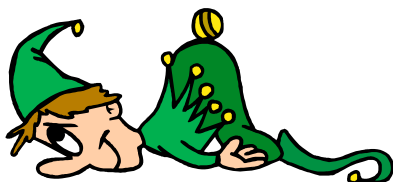
Show Information

Please take the time to read through the following information as this will help to ensure that the show runs smoothly

Walking the courses: Courses at each level will be the same for all sizes of dogs. All handlers need to walk the course before the first class at their level, regardless of the height jumps are set at. **Please note that all Starters and Novice Plus classes have been combined into Starters Plus.**

Getting to the line: Please be aware of when you need to run your dogs! If you have multiple dogs to run please stagger your runs to make sure that the end of the class is not delayed whilst the Judge waits for you to go and get your next dog. If you have a Tiny dog, please get your dogs to the line whilst people are still walking the course if the class starts with Tiny dogs (as indicated on the Ring Plan), or, if the class starts with Medium dogs, please bring your Tiny dogs to the ring whilst the Small dogs are running.

Don't forget to play your Jokers! At each Agility Nuts show this summer you get the opportunity to double the league points you gain from a single class on each day by playing your Joker. You simply decide which class you want to play your joker in and let the ring party know when you book in. A coloured sticker will be placed on your scribe sheet to indicate that you are playing your joker. **You can only play ONE joker per dog per day at each show and you must declare that you are playing the joker BEFORE the run!** Anyone who plays more than one joker will have league points deducted!



Trophy Pet Foods Open Jumping Pairs Entries: We will be taking additional entries for both Pairs classes at the show up to 1:30 pm on the Saturday of the show. The Pairs classes will consist solely of jumps and tunnels. Running orders for these classes will be generated once all additional entries have been taken and will be displayed in the Show Office.

Pay on the Day Classes

We are pleased to offer extra agility fun and competitions on both days of the show*

SATURDAY: It's a Knockout Jumping Challenge

SUNDAY: Open Steeplechase Challenge

**Time and weather permitting. Listen out for announcements at the show. Entries will be £2 per dog, payable on the day. All heights and standards welcome to enter. Veterans and NFC dogs can enter and run at their usual height. Rosettes to 3rd in all Pay on the Day classes.*

Day parking: Please park vehicles as directed.

Dogs in cars: Your dog is vulnerable and at risk if left in a vehicle at high temperatures, even on days that you may only consider to be slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for the damage caused.

Camping: Camping is available from midday on the Friday before the show starts. All campers must vacate the venue by midday on the Monday after the show has finished. All camping units must have a fire extinguisher and/or bucket of water available. There are water taps available at the venue. Toilet facilities will be available on site. Please be aware that there is a reasonably tight turn over a bridge onto the venue. Assistance will be provided if needed. If in doubt, please ring the contact number displayed by the bridge and assistance will arrive very quickly.

About the venue: The venue is a private property and someone's home so please make sure you respect it. The exercise area(s) will be clearly marked and there is a lane where dogs can be walked just outside the venue. Areas that are out of bounds will be clearly marked and must be respected. All owners must pick up after their dogs – no exceptions! Bins for dog waste will be provided. Owners knowingly not picking up after their dogs will be asked to leave the venue and may be excluded from future Agility Nuts shows.

Helping at the Show: One of your ring cards will indicate which ring and when you are expected to help at the show. We ask that all competitors give 1 hour per day to help as specified to enable the smooth running of the show. Please report to your Ring Manager so that they can allocate a suitable job and time slot for you. Remember, no-one is expected to help at the expense of missing their classes. This is made a lot easier to achieve if everyone helps.

Catering: Food will be available in the main marquee.

Results: Agility Nuts will be using ringside entry of results with real-time updates of the current standings as each class runs available on monitor(s) located by the Show Office. Results and updated League Tables will be available on the Agility Nuts website (www.agilitynuts.co.uk) as soon as possible after the show.

Directions to venue

The venue is located off the A60 near the junction with the A52 south of Nottingham.

If travelling from the west of Nottingham:

- Follow the A52 towards Grantham
- At the junction (roundabout) with the A60 take the 3rd exit towards Loughborough
- Take the second exit on the left immediately after you enter Ruddington*

If travelling from the east of Nottingham:

- Follow the A52 towards Derby
- At the junction (roundabout) with the A60 take the 1st exit towards Loughborough
- Take the second exit on the left immediately after you enter Ruddington*

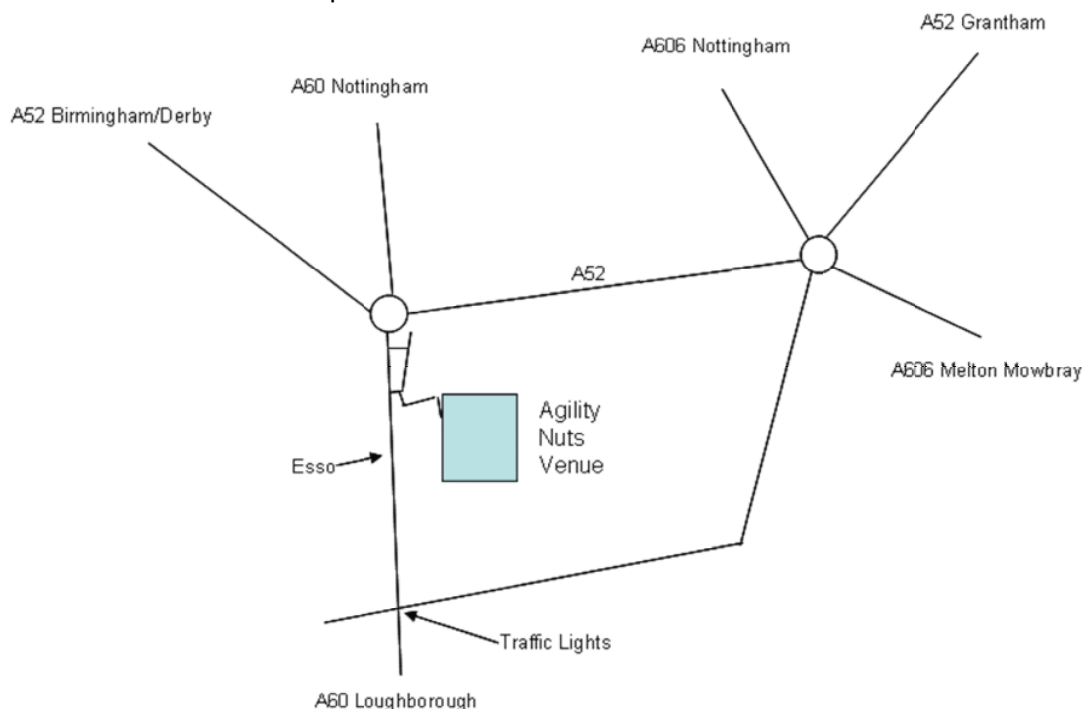
If approaching Nottingham from the south on the A60

- Go straight on at the traffic lights in Ruddington
- Take the first right after the Esso petrol station*

*Turn right immediately. Follow the track, turning right over a bridge into the venue. Follow the signs for camping/day parking.

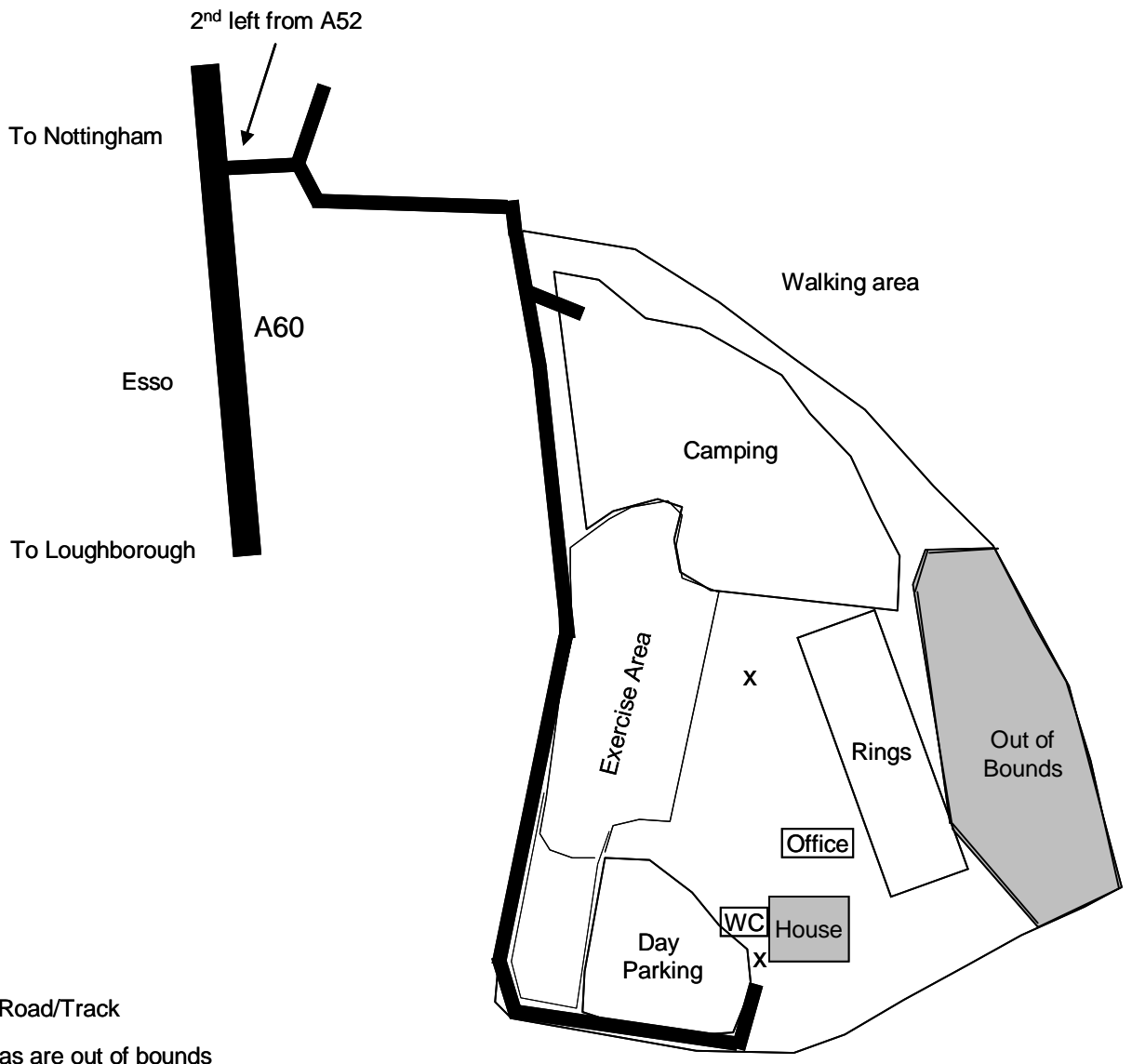
Note to Sat Nav users

The postcode NG11 6LJ actually takes you close to the Esso petrol station on the A60 mentioned above. If travelling from the A52 use the instructions above to turn off before you reach the petrol station. If travelling from the south on the A60 turn off after the petrol station as indicated above.

AGILITY NUTS Triathlon

The 4 Muddy Paws Triathlon will take place on Sunday 19th and will include a Run/Walk event, an Obedience Test and the Time Fault & Out Jumping event being held at the show. Late entries will be accepted up to and including June 18th.

Rules & Schedule of events

- **THE SAME PAIRING OF HANDLER AND DOG MUST TAKE PART IN EACH OF THE THREE EVENTS**
- Competitors must collect their number before the first event. Numbers are available from 7.30 a.m. at the marshalling area.
- Competitors taking part with two dogs will be issued with consecutive numbers
- Numbers must be worn whilst taking part in all three events
- There will be prizes for the top three competitors overall, i.e. the competitors with the **LOWEST RANKING SUM** from the three events
- Prizes are donated by 4 Muddy Paws dog grooming of Cotgrave

Run/Walk

- The route is as shown, with the marshalling area in the vicinity of the bridge at the entrance to the venue. Maps will be on display and marshals will be out on the course.
- Competitors must assemble **AT THE MARSHALLING AREA BY 7.50 A.M**
- The run will start promptly at 8.00 a.m.
- Competitors will be set off at equal time intervals according to their race number, i.e. number 1 will start at 8.00 a.m.
- If you have entered 2 dogs you may run with both at the same time, but you will need to wear both race numbers.
- Any competitor arriving late will only be allowed to run at the starter's discretion.
- Dogs must be kept on the lead throughout the run. **NO EXTENDABLES.**
- If you are overtaking another runner please do so **ON THE RIGHT.**
- Please keep to the left of any oncoming runners.
- Please return after your run if you need to pick up after your dog.
- As you finish the run your time will be recorded and your actual run time calculated



Obedience

- Obedience judging will take place in a dedicated ring from 9.30 a.m. onwards.
- You may complete the test at any time during the morning and does not have to be done in strict number order.
- Your dog will receive a score for each aspect of the test and then an overall score.

Time Fault and Out Jumping

- TFO Jumping will take place in the afternoon as part of the main agility show.
- Competitors will compete at their usual level, i.e. Elementary, Starters Plus or Veteran, and at their usual jump height.
- Scores in these classes will be carried over to make the third event of the triathlon.
